The Faculty of Mass Media Communication in Trnava (FMK) was established in 1997. It is a modern, dynamically growing and ambitious institution. With a very specific position in the Slovak Republic it is unique, the largest and the most complex media school in the country. The faculty is considered to be the most desirable among students interested in media studies and belongs to the ten most prestigious faculties in Slovakia.

It is located in the historic city Trnava. The city is located in the centre of the Trnava region with 66 000 inhabitants which makes it to be the 7th largest in Slovakia. It lies close to the capital Bratislava, connected by highway. It is also close to the borders with Austria, the Czech Republic and Hungary.

What is the study program Media Relations about?


Among professionals the term **media relations** is generally understood as regular communication with the media. It aims at maintaining a good relationship with journalists interested in the issue of the company or public institution. Relations with the media are based on the production of information attractive to the addressed media about the topic and consequently the interest of recipients of media contents for companies, organizations, their products or services. Media relations represents the creation of a good relationship with subjects involved in media communication.

"Jama"
















How to get there?



ACCOMMODATION

Trnava has several student residences. Incoming students can also find accommodation in private rooms in flats shared with other students. The cost of accommodation varies from 50€ to 200€ for month depending on the type.

WHERE TO EAT

Students coming to Trnava will not be disappointed with the meals offered in the student restaurant "TOP RELAX", Nám. J. Herdu 2, Trnava. It offers a varied menu consisting of soup, main courses, salads and drinks. Every day there are four main types of meals (meats, pastries, vegetables, healthy foods). Every day lunch starts at 10:30 and the price is 1,95€ / lunch. It is necessary to buy lunch tickets of at least 5 at a time.

Also there is an open buffet which includes freshly packed baguettes, toasted breads, gyros, pastries, vegetable, pasta or fruit salads, desserts and a wide range of sweet and salty snacks and drinks. The buffet opens every day at 8:00. Two more buffets are located in the buildings at "Jama" and "Skladová".




LIVING IN TRNAVA

Geography

Trnava is located in western Slovakia and it is the capital of the Trnava region. Thanks to the many churches within the city walls it has often been called "Little Rome" or "Slovak Rome". The city is located in the Danubian Lowlands on the Trnávka river. It is around 45 kilometers north-east of the capital, Bratislava. The closest mountain ranges are the Little Carpathians to the west and the Považský Inovec to the north-east of the city.

Main sights

As early as the Middle Ages, Trnava was an important center of Gothic religious and lay architecture. St. Nicolas's Church, St. Helen's Church and several church monastery complexes were built in this period. The Renaissance added a town tower to Trnava's silhouette. In the 17th century the erection of the St. John the Baptist Church and the university campus launched a building rush that continued with the reconstruction of the Franciscan and Clarist's complexes. Among recent constructions are the Holy Trinity Statue and the group of statues of St. Joseph, the Ursulinian and the Trinitarian Church and Monastery. Time Zone

The Slovak Republic belongs to the time zone UTC+1 A, CET (Central European Time).

Currency

The currency of the Slovak Republic is the Euro (€). Euro notes come in seven denominations: 5, 10, 20, 50, 100 and 500 Euro. Coins are in eight denominations: 1, 2, 5, 10, 20, 50 cent and 1 and 2 Euro. There is 100 cents to the 1 Euro.

Telephone

Most people in Slovakia use a mobile phone and students are advised to purchase a mobile phone on arrival in Slovakia. A cheaper option is to purchase a SIM card to use in your own phone. There are four mobile companies in Slovakia: Orange Slovensko, Slovak Telekom a.s., O2 Slovakia s.r.o. and SWAN a.s. The international dialing code for Slovakia is +421.

How to spend your free time?

Trnava offers many opportunities to spend leisure time, including sport activities, cinemas, theatre and many cafes, bars and restaurants. Walking around the city is an interesting experience thanks to its architecture and beautiful square. Often you can see people riding bicycles through the city, which is a typical means of transport for many of them.

There are also many fitness centres, swimming pools and wellness, too. In the evenings or during weekends students usually meet in local cafes or bars. Some of them are "Čajka", "Cerveza", "Art klub", "Partizáni" or "Raspberry". It is typical also to take breakfast in one of the cafes in the city centre, for example in "Thalmeiner" or "Synagóga Café".

The faculty often organizes events for students such as breakfasts, trips, parties, thematical days, festivals, balls, conferences or sport activities. At the university you can spend your free and study time in the newly opened student zone equipped with a kitchen.
